**DIRECTIONS TO
CAMDEN COUNTY COLLEGE**

From South Jersey: Take Rt. 42 or the Black Horse Pike North. Take the exit for Rt. 168 for Blackwood-Sicklerville. Turn right at the bottom of the ramp. Turn right at the first traffic light (onto Rt. 168 North). Turn right at the first road onto College Drive. The entrance to the college is one mile down the road on the right.

From the Atlantic City Expressway: Take Exit 44. Stay in the right lane and take the first exit for Rt. 168 for Blackwood-Sicklerville. Turn right at the bottom of the ramp. Turn right at the first traffic light (onto Rt. 168 North). Turn right at the first road onto College Drive. The entrance to the college is one mile down the road on the right.

From the NJ Turnpike: Take Exit 3 and follow the ramp to southbound Rt. 168 for Blackwood-Atlantic City. Continue southbound on Rt. 168 for 5 miles before turning left onto College Drive. Turn right at the first traffic light onto Peter Cheeseman Road. The campus is on the right.

From Rt. 295: Take Rt. 295 South, continuing on Rt. 42 South. Take the Blackwood-Clementon exit. Turn right at the bottom of the ramp onto Blackwood-Clementon Road. Turn right at the first traffic light onto Erial Road. Follow Erial Road to the 2nd traffic light and turn right onto Little Gloucester Road. Continue straight past the next traffic light. The college is on the right.

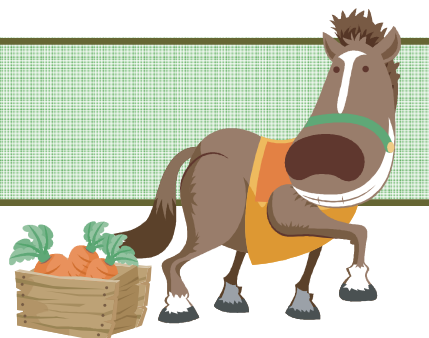
